Dear Parents/Guardians:

On the reverse side is a flyer informing you about a program to assist students with their homework. It is called Homework Hotline. There will be teachers from various subjects who will assist students with any questions or problems they may be experiencing when completing their homework. The schedule shows the days and times Homework Hotline will be available. The group will meet after school in the Library from 2:30 PM to 3:30 PM. Transportation is available via our late busses leaving the building at approximately 3:30 PM. You may also pick up your child if you elect to do so. Students will be able to participate in this program as soon as the permission slip on the reverse is signed and returned.

Homework Hotline was created to allow for a quiet place to study or get work done. In order to maintain an atmosphere conducive for students to accomplish those tasks, we have guidelines in place.

- All peer conversations must be kept to a whisper level.
- Students must arrive by 2:35 with their belongings.
- The availability of the computers is on a first-come-first-serve basis. Only the first 20 students to arrive and sign in will have the privilege to use the computers.
- Homework Hotline is only open to students that have and wish to do homework or study.
- The library as it functions during the day will be closed. No books or any materials can be read or borrowed.
- Seating arrangements, such as four to a table, will be discussed on an as needed basis throughout the year.

Failure to comply with any of the above rules will result in temporary or permanent removal from Homework Hotline along with any other necessary administrative action.

Please fill out and sign the bottom portion of the form and have your child return it to their homeroom teacher, but **keep the calendar**. Note: It is not necessary for your child to attend all of the scheduled days. Students may attend as needed.
